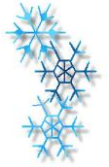







Snow Days.

It's Good to be Green.

You may have heard your children talking about our new behaviour system called 'It's Good to be Green'.

The Good to be Green scheme is an effective way of promoting **positive** behaviour, rewarding those children who consistently behave appropriately, and is a means of being able to track those pupils who find it harder to meet the school's expected behaviour code. We promote the language of choice and children are encouraged to take responsibility for their actions. It is very visual, with child friendly resources which allow our pupils to see how they are doing in class. We believe it is important to promote a positive message regarding behaviour management and the 'Good to be Green' system is a means of promoting high expectations of behaviour. Children have commented that they like the way the system rewards those children who always make the right choices, as they will be rewarded with 'Golden Time' on a Friday afternoon, choosing activities that interest them. In addition, two children from each class who consistently make the right choices will be chosen to attend the 'Good to be Green' tea party each half term. As with the rainbow/sun/cloud system we previously used, it teaches the children that there are consequences for behaviour that either disrupts learning or breaks our agreed school rules. It uses a 'warning' card and 'consequence' card and as before is linked to a loss of some break times/Golden Time if the wrong choices are persistently made.
