

Ofsted Inspection, March 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are thrilled to finally be able to share with you the findings of our latest Ofsted Inspection.

As you know Ofsted visited us on 15th and 16th March. This is our first inspection since 2013 so it was long overdue! When a school has previously been judged to be Good a Section 8 inspection is carried out. This inspection found that we continue to be a Good school.

Ofsted noticed the positive relationships between pupils and adults, where every child is well known by staff. Our pupils get off to a great start, right from the early years. They confirmed that leaders are ambitious for all pupils and that they enjoy their learning.

We shared our plans for developing the curriculum and Ofsted concurred that this was the right focus for all schools as we adapt to a new inspection framework. They described our school as a “well-oiled machine,” where everyone worked together really well. I think this really sums up Robert Miles Infant School as a place where we all (children, staff, families and the local community) work together to give our pupils the best possible start they can have.

I am so proud of our school and I'm pleased that this was recognised by Ofsted. According to the parent survey, 90% of you would recommend our school – this is great testament indeed.
