About the trip and costs



It is time for us to start planning our annual adventure to Perlethorpe for the Year 2 overnight stay. Miss Justice and Miss Woodhouse will be leading this valuable educational opportunity, where the children will undertake a range of activities during the day and then spend one night under canvas.

The cost will be £41.00 and this includes all travel, activities and meals.

Although the contributions are voluntary, because of further constraints on budgets school can no longer afford to run this trip at a loss. Without sufficient contributions the trip is at risk of being cancelled. **Therefore we are asking for a non-refundable deposit of £10.00 to be paid by Friday 28th February and the balance to be paid by 5th June.**

If your child is in receipt of pupil premium funding you will be entitled to help towards the cost of the trip - please see the school office for further details. If you believe your child may qualify for pupil premium funding but you haven't applied please speak to a member of the office team who will be able to talk you through how to apply.

If you would like to spread the cost of the visit over a number of weeks we are able to accommodate this and a payment card can be obtained from the office.

About the trip and costs



Please provide the following equipment and clothing into one small **NAMED** holdall or bag:

Name	Packed
NAMED drinks bottle filled with water	
Waterproof coat	
A warm sweater or fleece	
Pyjamas/something warm to sleep in - <i>(even if it is a hot day it can get very chilly during the night).</i>	
Underwear/socks	
Old trousers - <i>(no jeans-they are difficult to dry if they become wet).</i>	
Spare set of clothes	
Toothbrush, toothpaste <i>(and any other toiletries your child may need).</i>	
Comb or brush	
Trainers or sensible shoes	
Sunhat and sun lotion	
A pair of wellies <i>(essential due to river dipping-please test to ensure waterproof)</i> must be in a NAMED carrier bag please	
A warm sleeping bag - <i>(even if it is a hot day it can get very chilly during the night).</i>	
Pillow	
Torch	
A NAMED carrier bag for any wet/dirty clothes	

The children will be provided with a packed lunch by school. The school kitchen are aware of those children who have specific allergies.

The children **WILL** get wet when they are river dipping and need a change of clothes. Please **DO NOT** send their best clothes.

Your child will not need to bring any money as we will not be visiting any shops.

We are encouraging children to be more independent and look after their own things so please make sure **ALL** items are clearly labelled with your child's name, including any bags, equipment, pillows etc.

Please ask if you have any questions.

Camp Rules



We will be talking through the rules in class but please make sure your child understands what is expected of them.

We look after everyone else on camp and make sure they're alright.

We listen carefully and do what we're asked straight away.

We ask an adult if we're not sure about something.

We stay inside the camp area.

We walk around the tents.

We always take our shoes off before we go in the tents.

We never go in the kitchen.

We never go off on our own or with someone we don't know.

We never go anywhere without telling someone.

We close our eyes and go straight to sleep when we are in our sleeping bags.

We will remind children our school rules and expectations will still apply during the trip.


