
Just in case.... **SNOW PROCEDURES**

There are a **very large** number of children arriving late for school each morning. Children need to be on the playground when the bell rings at **8.45am**. Being late for school has a negative impact on your child's learning, as they start their activities straight away. Being just 10 minutes late every day adds up to an hour a week of lost learning. Over a year this adds up to one week of school missed in a year! Being late for class often means important instructions are missed and the class is interrupted. Your child may feel uncomfortable and on the outer with peers. Children need to arrive on time ready to settle into their school work. We appreciate your co-operation with this.
